From the tip of the spectacular North Island to the bottom of the South Island, this journey offers a wealth of wonderful experiences. Day 1: Welcome to Auckland

Day 3: Rotorua Included Choice

Day 4: Rotorua – Wellington Journey through pine forests and verdant farmland to spectacular Huka Falls and serene Lake Taupo. Travel south over the Central Plateau and along the Kapiti Coast to Wellington. Enjoy an exclusive after-hours guided tour of Te Papa Museum of New Zealand. Before leaving there, top off the night with a Highlight Dinner. Hotel: James Cook Grand Chancellor, Wellington. B BG HD

Day 5: Wellington – Blenheim

You can discover more of Wellington this morning. Perhaps visit the Parliament buildings and the 'Beehive', home to New Zealand's politicians. Cruise the Cook Strait into tranquil Queen Charlotte Sound and travel on to the villages of Picton and sunny Blenheim. Day 6: Blenheim – Christchurch

Travel to Kaikoura, where sperm whales can often be seen not far from shore (an optional whale-watching flight is available). On arrival in Christchurch see the extensive work carried out to rebuild the city after the earthquake of 2011. Hotel: Distinction Hotel, Christchurch. B

Day 7: Christchurch – Twizel

Day 8: Twizel – Dunedin Included Choice

View the massive Waitaki Hydro Power Scheme and Benmore Dam this morning before stopping in at the harbour-side township of Oamaru with its celebrated white limestone buildings. Then you'll make your way to New Zealand's southernmost city, Dunedin. This afternoon choose one from a range of Included Choice sightseeing experiences. Tour stately Larnach Castle, ride the historic Taieri Gorge railway, take a wildlife cruise, or experience an interactive tour of famous Speight's Brewery. Hotel: Scenic Hotel Southern Cross, Dunedin. B DW

Day 9: Dunedin – Te Anau

Today, travel through lush green sheepgrazing country on your way to the town of Te Anau on the shores of Lake Te Anau, the South Island's largest lake. Hotel: Distinction Hotel, Te Anau. B DW

Day 10: Te Anau – Queenstown

You'll experience the magnificence of Fiordland National Park today. Explore the length of Milford Sound on a Nature Cruise. Learn about the history of the region and benefit from the knowledge of your specialist nature guide. After disembarking, travel on to beautiful Queenstown. Hotel: Millennium Hotel, Queenstown, 2 nights. B

Day 11: Queenstown Included Choice

Day 12: Queenstown – Franz Josef

Enjoy the tastes of stone fruit at Cromwell, before travelling over Haast Pass and view the sheer drop of Thunder Creek Falls on your way to the extraordinary Franz Josef Glacier. You may want to view the glacier on a helicopter flight (own expense). This evening, enjoy dinner at your hotel. Hotel: Scenic Franz Josef Glacier (Douglas Wing), Franz Josef. B DW

Day13: Franz Josef – Punakaiki

Explore the glacier this morning, then spend some time amongst temperate rainforest giants on the West Coast Treetop Walkway. Travel to Hoktika, home of New Zealand's famous greenstone, then on to Punakaiki. You'll spend the night in an eco-friendly resort right on the waterfront. Hotel: Punakaiki Resort, Punakaiki. B DW

Day 14: Punakaiki – Christchurch

Board the iconic TranzAlpine train in the village of Arthur's Pass this afternoon and embark on one of the world's most scenic rail journeys. Back in Christchurch, join your Travel Director for a Farewell Dinner. Hotel: Distinction Hotel, Christchurch. B FD

Day 15: Farewell from Christchurch

Say farewell to your fellow travellers when your holiday comes to an end this morning after breakfast. B
