You'll have time to relax before meeting your Travel Director and fellow travellers for a Welcome Reception. **Hotel: Ibis.**

2 Christchurch - Omarama

Drive over the rich alluvial farmlands of the Canterbury Plains to Lakes Tekapo and Pukaki. Pause to view the iconic Church of the Good Shepherd before revelling in the alpine landscape of Mt. Cook National Park. Hotel: Heritage Gateway. B D

3 Omarama – Dunedin Free Time

Travel along the Waitaki River via Oamaru, with its famous white limestone buildings, to Dunedin, a region of unique landscapes and fascinating cultural history, for an orientation tour and free time. **Hotel: Kingsgate. B**

4 Dunedin Free Time – Milford Sound

Journey through native rainforests, alluvial flats and meadows. Stop at Mirror Lakes, where you can see the stunning mountain scenery perfectly reflected in the crystal waters. Then on through the hand-hewn Homer Tunnel. As you emerge, you are presented with one of the world's most dramatic alpine drives, down through the Cleddau Valley to Milford Sound. Your magical overnight cruise meanders down the Sound, taking in Bowen and Stirling Falls and the sheer pinnacle of Mitre Peak. Cruise: Overnight Milford Sound. B D

5 Milford Sound – Queenstown

Depart for Lake Te Anau. Explore the famous Te Anau Glowworm Caves by boat, before travelling to Queenstown, the adventure capital. **Hotel:** Copthorne Hotel and Resort, 3 nights. B

8 Queenstown - Franz Josef

Your destination is the wild West Coast of the South Island. Visit the gold mining settlement of Arrowtown, and then travel over Haast Pass and view the sheer drop of Thunder Creek Falls on your way to Franz Josef Glacier. **Hotel: Scenic Franz Josef Glacier, Graham Wing. B D**

9 Franz Josef – Punakaiki

Explore this astounding glacier on foot or from the air this morning (both optional). Travel to Hokitika, home of New Zealand's famous greenstone, then on to Punakaiki to view the intriguing Pancake Rocks and Blowholes. You'll spend the night in an eco-friendly resort right on the waterfront. Hotel: Punakaiki Resort. B D

10 Punakaiki – Nelson

The Heritage Highway leads you through a scenic wilderness to the plunging Buller Gorge and pristine Kahurangi National Park. **Hotel: Rutherford, 2 nights. B**

On this day at leisure have the opportunity to journey to the top of the South Island and enjoy a relaxing cruise in the Abel Tasman National Park, or perhaps take a short bush walk, relax in sunny Nelson or explore the many arts and craft shops. **B**

12 Nelson – Wellington

Visit the seaside village of Picton with free time to explore. Cruise on tranquil Queen Charlotte Sound before heading across Cook Strait to the North Island and Wellington, New Zealand's capital. [9] Enjoy a city sights tour before an evening at leisure. Hotel: Travelodge, 2 nights. B
