Dunedin – Omarama

Set out for Oamaru, with its elegant tree-lined streets and celebrated white limestone buildings. Later, pass the monumental Waitaki Hydro Power Scheme and Benmore Dam on your way to Omarama. **Hotel: Heritage Gateway. B D**

8 Omarama – Christchurch

Journey through Aoraki Mt. Cook National Park. See Lakes Pukaki and Tekapo, and stop to view the Church of the Good Shepherd before traversing the Canterbury Plains to Christchurch. **Hotel: Ibis. B D**

Ohristchurch – Picton

13 Rotorua – Auckland

This morning you'll travel through the King Country region to Waitomo Caves. Experience the natural beauty underground on a guided tour through the world-famous Waitomo Glowworm Grotto. Descend an illuminated staircase of curving limestone to caverns lit by twinkling blue and green glowworms. This afternoon you'll follow the meandering trail of the Waikato River, New Zealand's longest river, past the lush farmlands of the Waikato Region. As you journey over the Bombay Hills, the landscape changes from green, grassy meadowlands to the edges of suburbia. When you make your way into the heart of New Zealand's largest city, you will stop at the Auckland War Memorial Museum for views across Auckland City and the Waitemata Harbour. **Hotel: Holiday Inn Express. 14 Auckland – Bay of Islands

Depart Auckland and head to Paihia in the Bay of Islands. This afternoon discover the stories, people and events that shaped the past, present and future of Aotearoa New Zealand at the Waitangi Treaty Grounds. During your tour you will view the world's largest ceremonial war canoe, the historic Treaty House and carved Meeting House. Today is a completely free day for you to experience the beauty of the Bay of Islands. Perhaps take a coach trip to Cape Reinga, the very top of New Zealand, via idyllic Ninety Mile Beach or experience a day of sailing aboard a historic tall ship. Enjoy wine tasting in Kerikeri or a tour of Russell to learn more about the settling of the Bay of Islands. **B**
